

Choosing a Color Palette: Select a base color and accent shades that complement it. Neutrals are great as they're versatile, while bold colors can make a statement.


Lighting Types:


Ambient Lighting: General lighting, like ceiling fixtures, that illuminates the whole room.

Task Lighting: Lights for specific tasks like reading or cooking (e.g., desk lamps or under-cabinet lighting).


Accent Lighting: Used to highlight architectural features or artwork (e.g.,
